Social Media

Encourage your followers to check out CDSE's programs for professional development by posting content on your platforms once a week for 30 days. Social Media posts can be used in one of two ways:

- 1) Use the YouTube links provided in the sample posts to accompany the PSA
- 2) Use the downloaded PSA from DVIDS and upload them directly to your social media platforms

We recommend using the provided social media posts on a weekly basis on each platform; alternating the tweet/post language between the weeks.

Social Media Tip: Tweets and posts with hashtags, images, GIFs, and linked content are more likely to receive interaction from your audiences!

DVIDS Downloading Instructions

For DoD users, visit the URL listed herein to download video for use within your organization. On the right-hand side under the "Options" list, select "Download Video." After selecting to download, a window will pop up asking you to either open the file or save it to your machine.

Video Graphics

Images are provided as a frame of reference. When you upload the links to your social media platforms, an image from the video you use will appear.

CDSE PSA Guidelines

When using the CDSE PSA, please follow the below guidelines:

- You may not pay to have the PSAs played on any TV, radio or digital channel. They can only be placed in donated media.
- You may not edit or alter, create derivatives of, or otherwise attempt to modify or use CDSE PSAs in any way other than expressly authorized.
- Stakeholders cannot use any PSA footage to create other PSAs.
- CDSE reserves the right, in our sole discretion and at any time, to ask you to remove PSAs from any media channel where you have placed them that we may deem inappropriate.
- All files are provided in compliance with Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act, to ensure the accessibility for people with disabilities. Closed captions may not be turned off on video PSAs when disseminated, and if stakeholders create their own video PSAs, those must be closed captioned as well.

Media Content Restrictions

Partners and stakeholders must avoid placing any of the CDSE PSAs near content or websites that:

- Include explicit or gratuitous displays of violence, profanity, sex, pornography, nudity, and antisocial behavior.
- Engage in or promote disparaging, prejudicial, derogatory, discriminatory or violent treatment of any individual or group.
- Sensationalize the neglect, abuse, or suffering of any person or animal.
- Exploit or promote highly dangerous or inappropriate situations or behaviors for minors.

• Incite violent acts toward the government or the public, including but not limited to domestic and international terrorism.
