

GSA Approved Security Containers

GSA Global Supply provides full-service acquisition management support to help you acquire approved security containers that conform to federal specifications and standards. These containers are for the storage of classified documents, components, material, equipment, funds, valuables, and weapons. All GSA approved containers must have a GSA approval label or a GSA recertification label on the front of the equipment in order to store classified national security information (NSI) or weapons.

Effective October 1, 2012, classified national security information **cannot** be stored in Non-GSA approved security containers per 32 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 2001.43(b), “Requirements for physical protection.” Any classified materials stored in Non-GSA approved security containers should be moved to other authorized storage containers.
