If you are in need of a locksmith to work on a GSA lock, vault, or container, there are a few ways to find one.

1. Reach out to your security manager and/or building maintenance personnel to see if they have a local resource.
2. Check with your local Public Works department to see if they have a local resource.
3. Contact the two schools that offer training on approved methods of servicing, installing, diagnosing, troubleshooting, repairing and certifying GSA locks, vaults and containers. These schools keep a list of individuals that have gone through their GSA Authorized Safe and Vault Technician course. See their contact information below.
