SUBJECT: Perfluorinated Compounds/Perfluoroalkyl Substances (PFC/PFAS) –  
Identification of Potential Areas of Concern (AOCs)

The Department of the Navy (DON) is committed to identifying, evaluating, and where appropriate, remediating contamination resulting from its activities. DON will take immediate action to remove imminent threats to human health and the environment. References (a) through (f) set the policies and requirements for conducting environmental restoration within the DON and Department of Defense (DoD) under the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP), including those relative to emerging contaminants, such as PFC/PFAS.

PFC/PFAS are a suite of chemicals of emerging public health concern, primarily in drinking water systems. In some cases, DON activities have resulted in the release of PFC/PFAS, which have contaminated drinking water sources. The primary DON release of PFC/PFAS was through the use of aqueous film forming foam (AFFF) for fire and emergency responses and during test and training activities. EPA recently established a lifetime health advisory level of 70 parts per trillion (ppt) for two PFC/PFAS, perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS), combined.

The DERP process can take many years to identify new sites, investigate soil and groundwater, and conduct cleanup actions. To expedite the timeframe to address PFC/PFAS, DON has developed and is implementing the process described in enclosure (1) to efficiently identify, validate, and prioritize the inventory of Sites and Areas of

Concern (AOCs) with known, or potential, PFC/PFAS releases. NAVFAC has identified and is validating the initial DERP Site and AOC list (step 6 of enclosure (1)) for active and Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) installations. Enclosure (2) lists DERP Sites with potential PFC/PFAS contamination and potential AOCs identified to date. The list identifies the installations, Site or AOC name(s), description, and the NAVFAC Environmental Restoration (ER) managers for each installation, with contact information at the bottom.

We suspect there are additional AOCs that must be identified and addressed. Enclosure (3) contains a summary of potential PFC/PFAS release mechanisms. For each installation under your command, this policy directs you to review the information in Enclosures (2) and (3) to assist NAVFAC validating the potential AOCs in Enclosure (2) and identify additional PFC/PFAS AOCs based on staff review of historical records (e.g. crash sites, fire responses, operations, training, etc.), databases, personnel interviews, etc. For new AOCs, identify the source of release, location of the release on an installation map or figure, and the source of the information used to identify the release. The NAVFAC ER managers identified in enclosure (2) will assist your staff throughout this effort. In order to complete the prioritization of all potential DERP-eligible Sites and AOCs and begin investigations of priority 1 sites (steps 8-14 of enclosure (1)) this fiscal year, I request you report newly identified PFC/PFAS AOCs and supporting information described above to my office and the NAVFAC ER managers by July 22, 2016.



**Phase 1 – Initial DERP Site  
Identification Database  
Screening**

- Develop list of keywords related to use of PFCs (including AFFF and other specified keywords)
- ER Program (ER,N & BRAC) Databases (NORM, NIRIS, Delayed Disposal Report, Military Fire & Crash Training Sites Table, BRACMIS, Flash Card, NOSC.Net, and Other Databases)

**Status/Schedule:**  
**COMPLETE**



**Business Rules:**

- Block 1: Develop a list of keywords to perform an initial screening of ERP (ER,N and BRAC) databases. Keywords provide a broad range of sites/AOCs that have the potential for PFC/PFAS use or release.  
Keywords include but not limited to single or combinations of these words: fire crash training, burn area, plating shop, fire train, fire fight, firefight, burn, hangar, AFFF, foam, plating.
- Block 2: The ERP database search will develop an initial “universe” of potential evaluation areas [existing ERP sites (NORM) or AOCs (NIRIS, other databases)].
- Block 3: Any ERP site/AOC in the databases with a keyword match will be included as a potential PFC/PFAS evaluation area for further screening.
- Block 4: ERP sites/AOCs in the databases having no keyword matches will be excluded from further PFC/PFAS use/release evaluation.

## Enclosure 1

### PFC/PFAS DERP Site and AOC Identification, Validation, Prioritization, and Response Process

#### Phase 2 – Site/AOC Validation, Prioritization and Gap Analysis


- Managers and RPMs to validate sites/AOCs progressing from Phase 1
- Prioritize sites/AOCs based on property ownership status, response status, and distance to drinking water sources
- CNIC and USMC to review validated sites/AOC lists per installation with potential release mechanisms and identify additional sites/AOCs for prioritization
- May include limited sampling of groundwater.

#### Status/Schedule:

- Block 6: Initial list is due 15 June 2016 to DASN(E)
- Block 7: A continuous process; initial validated AOCs to be added to the list by 22 July 2016 with additional sites added as discovered.
- Blocks 11, 13, 14, and 9: Potential sites/AOCs list due to DASN(E):
  - Batch 1: 01 August 2016
  - Batch 2: 15 August 2016
- Additional AOCs from CNIC & USMC will be prioritized as they are identified.

 Batch 1 – without potential sites/AOCs identified by CNIC/USMC

 Batch 2 – with potential sites/AOCs identified by CNIC/USMC



#### Business Rules:

- Block 5: FEC RPMs to confirm/refute PFCs sites/AOCs based on available data on site history and site operations. RPM is to provide the supporting documentation of “negative” response. For example, a “burn pit” site/AOC for debris disposal and not associated with fire-fighting training can be eliminated. Because some of the required information pertains to on-base and off-base drinking water sources, the RPM will need to coordinate with Environmental Compliance, Public Work, and local municipalities.
- Block 7: Additional areas that have the potential for PFC releases will be identified by facility operations personnel (i.e. hangar, crash site, storage area). Coordinate and work closely with RPMs to identify and validate new potential AOCs.
- Block 8: Could be identified from NORM, NIRIS, Delayed Disposal Report, Military Fire & Crash Training Sites Table, BRACMIS, Flash Card, real estate, & other databases
- Block 10: DWS (Navy, public, and private wells) are located within 1 mile downgradient of sites/AOCs.
- Block 12: DWS (Navy, public, and private wells) are or may be located within 1 - 3 miles downgradient of sites/AOCs.
- Blocks 9, 11, 13, and 14: Refer to rules under Phase 3.



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**Phase 3 - Responses**

- Layout prioritization of actions which may include one or more of the followings:
  - Sample groundwater and/or drinking water wells
  - Eliminate exposure by providing alternate drinking water
  - Perform other time critical/interim actions
  - Perform appropriate CERCLA investigation to understand the CSM
  - Perform CERCLA remedial action, if necessary

**Status/Schedule:**

- Block 11: Immediate (CFY and FY+1)
- Block 13: FY+1 to FY+3; May be expedited only after Priority 1 Sites/AOCs have been addressed.
- Block 14: FY+3 to FY+5
- Block 9: FY+5 and beyond; may be expedited on case by case basis, in particular when requested by the regulators/stakeholders.



**Business Rules:**

- Block 11: PRIORITY 1 – Perform actions per Blocks 15 and 16 and perform time critical actions as necessary.
- Blocks 13 and 14: PRIORITY 2 and PRIORITY 3 – Perform actions per Blocks 15 and 16.
- Block 9: PRIORITY 4 – PFC/PFAS evaluation pending additional review by ASN/NAVFAC HQ and regulatory request for assessment and may proceed to Blocks 15 and 16.
- Blocks 15 and 16: Develop a CSM to understand GW flow, PFC/PFAS migration potential off-base, and aquifer characteristics. This information may be obtained using existing and/or new MWs to verify the presence and level of PFC/PFAS in GW. If these results indicate impact to the DWS (downgradient and greater than 1 mile away), the DWS should be sampled with additional “step-out” sampling, if necessary.

Next step is to initiate the CERCLA site investigation to define nature and extent of the PFC/PFAS contamination, evaluate risk, and develop remedial alternatives, if necessary. Consider implementation of a removal action to implement a short-term solution to eliminate the use of bottled water.

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## ENCLOSURE 3 – PFC/PFAS RELEASE MECHANISMS

Within the Department of the Navy (DON)’s operations, PFC/PFAS are most commonly associated with AFFF, but can also be contained in some other materials and wastes/mixed wastes. The primary release mechanisms of PFC/PFAS to the environment within DON’s operations consist of *uses, non-point and point source releases such as spills and leaks, training activities, emergency responses, and testing* of PFC/PFAS containing material and wastes. DON will identify potential PFC/PFAS sites or areas of concerns based on the installation-side historical review of *known or suspected releases of PFC/PFAS* from the following potential release mechanisms.

1. Uses of AFFF containing PFC/PFAS in the following activities:
  - a. Firefighting and crash response vehicle testing where AFFF is discharged and not completely collected for proper disposal
  - b. Fire training exercises such as flooding a fire pit or other built facility or structure with flammable liquids (e.g. jet fuel), igniting the fluids, and subsequently extinguishing the fire with AFFF where the liquid is not completely contained and collected for proper disposal
  - c. Crash crew training exercises where releases occur from spraying AFFF at training sites and the liquid is not completely contained and collected for proper disposal
  - d. Hangar system operations, testing, and flooding; releases may occur from improper capture and disposal of AFFF in and around the hangars ditches where the foam migrated to and was thus released the ground or into draining channels or ditches
  - e. Responses to class B or fuel fires or spills and there was no containment of the liquids for proper disposal
  - f. Emergency response actions such as crash sites (aircraft, vehicle, and others)
2. Uses of material containing PFC/PFAS in the following industrial operation:
  - a. Plating shops – PFC/PFAS are sometimes contained in materials used in the vapor suppression system; releases could result from improper capture or disposal of material around floor drains, foundation cracks, and outdoor soil or ditch areas
3. Storage, handling, or disposal of PFC/PFAS contained in AFFF and materials or wastes
  - a. Release from improper filling of storage tanks, firefighting trucks, or crash response vehicles
  - b. Release from spills and leaks from storage tanks and piping
  - c. Releases from landfills or burn areas where the materials or wastes were/are disposed
