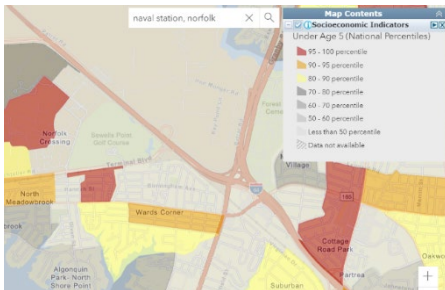

NAVFAC Open Environmental Restoration Resources (OER2) Webinar: Environmental Justice for Environmental Restoration Sites

Environmental justice refers to the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all individuals, regardless of race, color, national origin, or income, in the development, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies. This NAVFAC OER2 webinar will provide an overview of environmental justice considerations and *Executive Order 12898 - Federal Actions to Address Environmental Justice in Minority Populations and Low-Income Populations*. NAVFAC will discuss examples of including low income or minority populations in a project's community engagement. In addition, the webinar will address how to involve these populations and help to ensure they can participate in the public process at Department of the Navy (DON) Environmental Restoration sites. The webinar will also explore NAVFAC's involvement in the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Environmental Justice Pilot Project. In this collaboration, NAVFAC and the EPA implemented a six-step iterative process that integrates environmental justice considerations throughout the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) process.
